Washington Poison Center is your statewide, nonprofit resource on poison prevention and drug safety.

As one of 53 poison centers nationwide, we have been supporting community members and healthcare professionals for 69 years in navigating times of concern and crisis. Our specially trained pharmacists, nurses, and physicians help more than 60,000 patients each year, 24/7/365, with drug questions, potential poisonings, and overdose emergencies.

2024 Quick Stats

Poison Helpline: 1-800-222-1222

In 2024, we handled **119,731 calls** for a total of **62,166 patients**:

- 55,496 patients called about potential poisonings
- 6,643 patients called for information only
- We treated 93% of patients who called us first at home, avoiding the cost and stress of a hospital visit
- More than 27% of patients were already in a healthcare facility their care team called us for guidance and treatment recommendations
- There are only **5 board-certified medical toxicologist physicians** in Washington we ensured communities and healthcare providers had 24/7 access to their expertise

Public Health Education

In 2024, we:

- Participated in 188 events reaching 11,408 Washingtonians
- Distributed 22,441 Mr. Yuk stickers
- Conducted outreach to refugee and immigrant communities in 23 languages
- Trained 1,431 people on administering naloxone and distributed 2,290 doses of naloxone
